LIQUIDS, AEROSOLS AND GELS > 100ML



- LIQUIDS, AEROSOLS AND GELS < 100 ML PLACED IN A TRANSPARENT RESEALABLE BAG OF CAPACITY NOT EXCEEDING 1 LITRE
- ITEMS REQUIRED FOR MEDICAL OR DIETARY PURPOSES AND BABY FOOD PRODUCTS FOR USE DURING THE TRIP



LITHIUM BATTERIES POWERED DEVICES

Watt-hour rating calculation of one battery: $Wh = V \times Ah$

E-CIGARETTES, PERSONAL VAPORIZERS, RELATED ITEMS



(1) Transportation may be authorized as checked baggage subject to prior approval.

(2) Spare and power bank must be individually protected to prevent short circuits.

(3) If Watt-hour rating > 100 Wh and ≤ 160 Wh: maximum of 2 spare batteries and power bank per passenger. Prior approval from the airline for the device and/or batteries is mandatory.

EU Passenger rights

If you are denied boarding or if your flight is cancelled or delayed for at least 2 hours, ask at your check-in counter or boarding gate for the text stating your rights, particularly with regards to compensation and assistance. Regulation EC261/2004, Article 14 (1).
